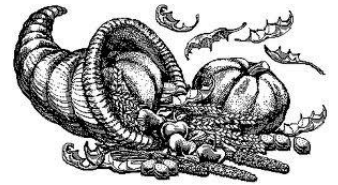


Lasqueti Island Fall Fair
