The Lasqueti Island Local Trust Committee would like to invite the public to attend a public hearing beginning at **11:00 am, Thursday, October 16, 2014** at the Lasqueti Arts Centre, Main Road, **Lasqueti Island, BC**, to hear your views regarding proposed Bylaw 89.

What is the Proposed Bylaw about?

Proposed Bylaw 89, if adopted, will amend the Lasqueti Island Land Use Bylaw to allow vehicle parking as a home enterprise. The amendment is intended to assist with alleviating traffic/parking congestion along road right-of-ways, particularly on False Bay hill. No OCP amendments are required.
